 - Carr 2011); Cobbett et al. (2016); Havrilla et al. (2018); Hunsicker & Chitwood (2018); Johnson et al. (2017); Serembus (2016); Sosa & Sethares (2015)
- Comprehensive Assessment/Project
 - College Requirement
 - Last semester prior to graduation





Recognizing the Need for Change

- Student indicators
 - Lack of motivation to succeed
 - Unprepared
 - Failure to utilize resources available




- Administrator indicators
 - Stonecypher et al. (2015)
 - Not meeting our benchmark
 - Consequences of failure
 - Sullivan (2014)
 - Retake policy



Our Plan to Increase Success

- Consultation with Kaplan
- Policy developed & approved by Department Faculty





The New Plan

- Ticket for Admission (TFA)
 - Series of tests recommended by Kaplan
 - Focused Review Exams
 - Fundamentals
 - Pharmacology
 - Management of Care
 - Question Trainers
 - Number of questions (75 to 265)
 - Question difficulty





The New Plan

- Ticket for Admission (TFA)
 - The rules:
 - Complete prior to scheduled Comprehensive Exam
 - Attain required score on each prep exam
 - Proof of remediation

❖Initiated in 2015




The Process

- 3 months prior to the Comprehensive Exam:
 - Students are informed of the Department policy, rules and expectations for the TFA
 - Contingency for failure of the Comprehensive Exam
 - Instructed regarding Kaplan resources
 - Date of Comprehensive Exam announced



1st Attempt Pass Rate: Pre/Post TFA





The Future

- Continue to analyze and share data with Faculty
 - Revise policy and procedures according to results
 - Set benchmarks
 - ❖ Decide on due date for TFA
 - Reinforce Kaplan resources/remediation in each course design

Inform students of policy, rules, and expectations









The Future Continued:

- Continue to collaborate with Kaplan
- Ongoing assessment:
 - Mee & Hallenbeck (2015)
 - Create focus groups to discuss:
 - the policy and rules
 - experience of TFA
 - value of TFA
 - Develop an evaluation form for students to complete
 - Develop a system to monitor student progress of TFA
