# 1,903 DNP AUTHORED SCHOLARLY PUBLICATIONS – 2012-2018

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#### Introduction

The Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) degree is a terminal degree with the highest level of preparation for nursing practice. Graduate outcomes are based on the Essentials of Doctoral Education for Advanced Nursing Practice (AACN, 2006). For over a decade, scholarly publications by these graduates have impacted practice.


#### Purpose




A secondary purpose is to use this synopsis as a starting point for continued and expanded examination into the DNP scholarly publications.

#### Methods


- Literature search through WorldCat Database
- Key Terms by Author: 'DNP;' Year: 2012-2018
- Inclusion Criteria: Peer-reviewed scholarly articles with at least one DNP credentialed author; includes research, education and clinical practice
- Search yielded 1,903 articles meeting criteria
- Sorted, categorized and reviewed data by year, authors' credentials, title and publication
