BACKGROUND

- Higher rate of cheating among nursing students than any other discipline
- Correlation between students who are dishonest and dishonest professional nurses
- State Boards of Nursing in several states have an increasing number of disciplinary actions reflecting loss of moral compass

PURPOSE

Assess moral courage among BSN nursing students.

SAMPLE

- N= 42
- Males= 8 Females = 34
- Age range= 18- 50
- Caucasian= 28, African American= 3, Hispanic= 5, American Indian= 1, Asian= 5.
- Practiced Religion: Christianity=
 32, Buddhism= 1, Judaism= 1,
 Agnostic/Atheist= 6, Spiritual= 1.
- Junior level= 8 Senior level= 34

PRELIMINARY RESULTS

You witness a fellow student cheating on his/her Pharmacology exam. How likely are you to report this event to your instructor?

A friend confides in you and a group of other students about wanting to use a friends' old research paper instead of writing their own. How likely are you to tell them, in front of the entire group, that this displays academic dishonesty?


