- Implemented June 4, 2013



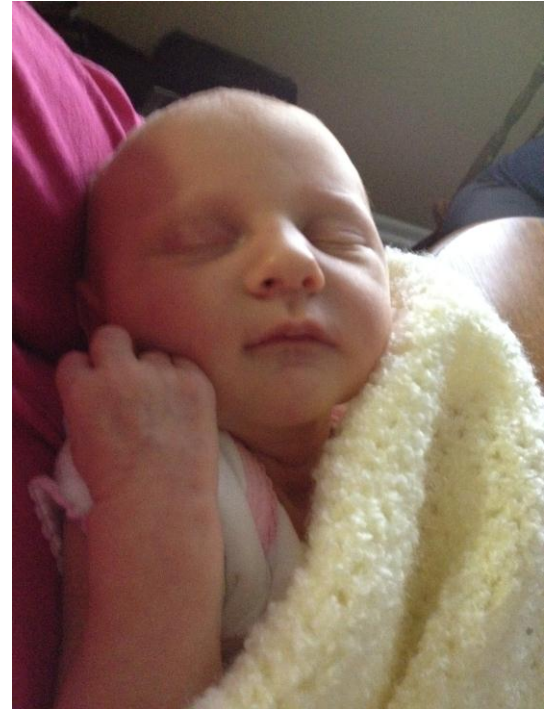

Pitocin Protocol

- Protocol
 - Pre-Use Checklist
 - In-Use Checklist
- Policy & Procedure
 - Standardized management
 - Standardized concentration



Pre-Use Checklist

- H&P completed documented
- Gestational age documented
- Cervical exam documented
- FHR documented as Category I or II
- Fetal presentation documented
- Oxytocin order placed
- Consent signed

In-Use Checklist

- Fetal parameters
 - Category I or II
 - No more than 1 late deceleration
 - No more than 2 variable decelerations
- Uterine parameters
 - No more than 5 contractions in 10 minutes averaged over 30 minutes
 - Uterine palpation soft between contractions
