- ☐ Hermeneutic-phenomenological method
- ☐ Semi-structured depth-interviews & focus group
- □ 12 nurse participants (years of service: 3-20)

Benner's model

- □ Novice
- ☐ Advanced beginner
- ☐ Competent
- ☐ Proficient
- ☐ Expert

Results.

- ☐ A four-leveled embodied knowledge of terminal care
- ☐ Learning without knowing (advanced beginner)
- ☐ Digging out things in control (competent)
- ☐ One step short of penetrating (proficient)
- ☐ Going with the life flow (expert)

Conclusion

- ☐ From nursing clinical experience to embodied knowledge
- ☐ Teaching hospice nursing experience on site & in school
